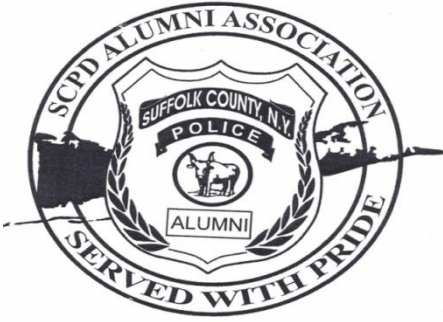

Over the last few years, we have received calls from Member's spouses or family members, at the time of the members passing (EOW). In many cases these grieving heirs have no idea who or how to report a member's EOW. Some are unsure of what Police organizations to notify and what to do about receiving any benefits they may be entitled to. With that in mind the SCPD Alumni has commissioned the distribution of an EOW guide for our members. This is a voluntary program. Each participating member is responsible for completing and distributing the EOW guide to their designated beneficiary or executor.

End of Watch guide Instructions

Download the EOW form our website www.scpdalumni.com or request a copy be sent via e-mail admin@scpdalumni.com or Phone 352-345-1778.

1. Fill in your personal information including NYS retirement ID, Retirement Rank and Date of Retirement
2. During the notification to the Police department, you should list any information related to your pistol permits.(# etc.)
3. Next select the appropriate line organization(s) you were a member of and list any anticipated benefit you may be eligible for. This may include Life Insurance, deferred compensation ,respective benefit fund notices (etc).
4. Notification to the NYS retirement system should include continuation of spouse or family member pension if applicable.
5. Notification to employee benefits is required to ensure continuation of spousal benefits

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6. Notification to Empire Blue is recommended to ensure continuation of spousal benefits if eligible.
7. List the fraternal organizations you may belong to along with any benefit you may be eligible for.
